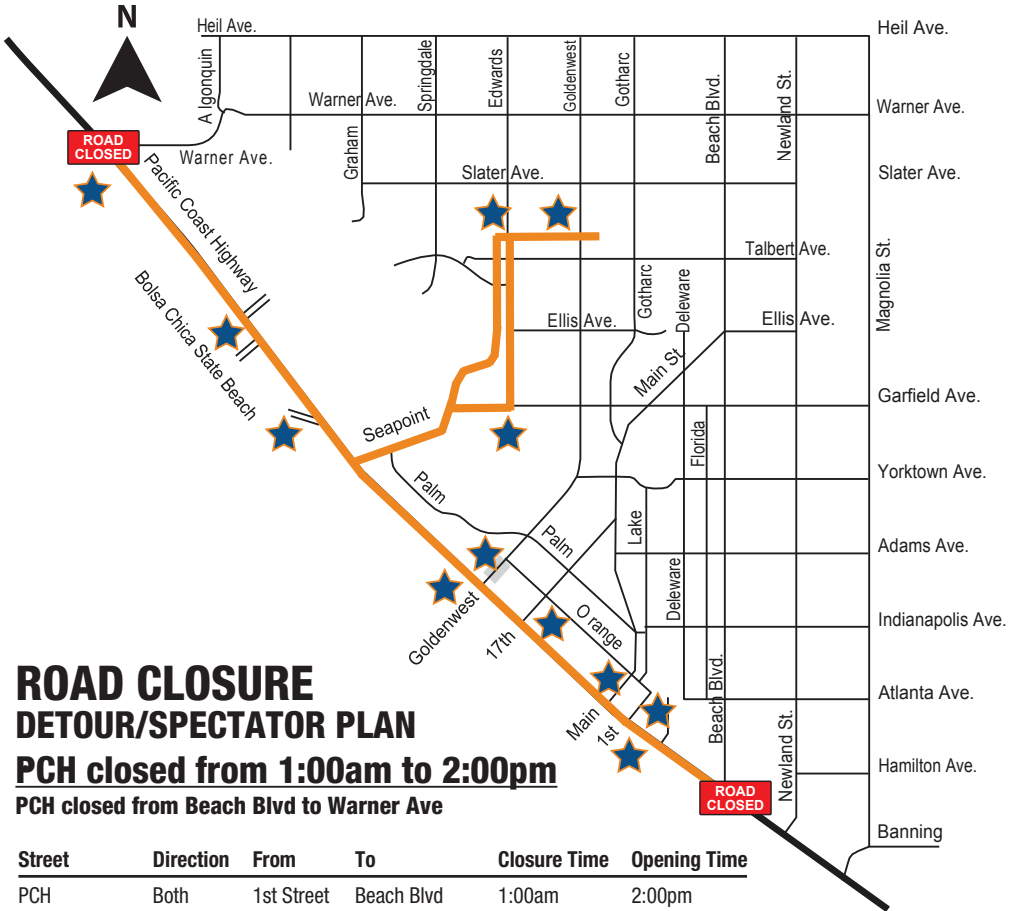

# NOTICE OF SPECIAL EVENT

## FEBRUARY 5, 2023

Dear Community Member:

Please mark your calendar for the RETURN of the Surf City Marathon on Sunday, February 5, 2023. This long-standing race offers scenic views of the Pacific Ocean and America's true "Surf City" as runners make their way to the finish line by way of Pacific Coast Highway and local city streets. This exciting weekend will include a two-day Active Lifestyle Expo by the water, Beach Mile on Saturday, February 4, and close with the marathon, half marathon and 5k on Sunday, February 5.

Community members are encouraged to join in on the weekend of activities! To plan your day accordingly, here are a few more important notes:

- The 2023 event course will require the closure of Pacific Coast Highway from Beach Boulevard to Warner Avenue. Pacific Coast Highway will be closed between 1 a.m. and 2 p.m. on Sunday, February 5. Detours will be in place.
- The race will begin at 6:30 a.m. near the Huntington Beach Pier, at the intersection of Huntington St and Pacific Coast Highway.
- All three distances (marathon, half, and 5k) will start in the northbound lanes along Pacific Coast Highway and return in the southbound lanes. Portions of the bike path will be utilized for the marathon route.
- Detours will be in place and law enforcement will be onsite to assist motorists when safe. For the safety of all involved, please obey all traffic signs and direction from law-enforcement.
